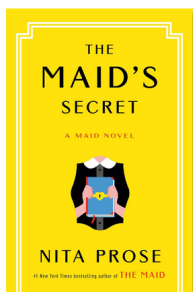
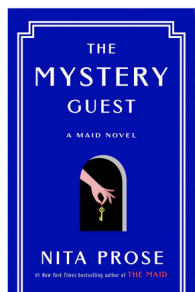
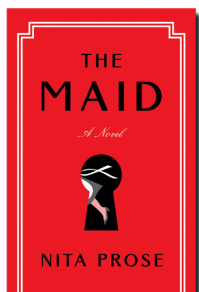
## SDG Reads 2025 Author Announced
